

# Spring Apron

Project of the Month #19

## Materials:

1 ½ yards main fabric for apron body:

Cut 36 inch panel by width of fabric. (Body of apron)

Cut 4 ½ inch strip by width of fabric (for straps)

Cut 9" strip by width of fabric (for quilting Insulbrite to hem)

1 ½ yard accent fabric for ties and straps.

Cut 1 strip 14" wide by width of fabric after embroidery this will be trimmed to 6"X28" after embroidery.

Cut five 6" strips by width of fabric. Cut one down to 6" X 28".

Leave other four strips width of fabric.

1/3 yard Insulbrite fleece

Cut 1 9" strip by width of fleece (for padding on hem of apron)

Floriani Water Soluble Topping

Floriani Embroidery Thread

Floriani Embroidery Suite

Edge Stitch Foot

Ruffler Foot attachment for sewing machine

Serger (Threaded for a 3 thread narrow overlock. **We will use Floriani embroidery thread in the upper and lower loopers. Serger thread to match fabric in needle.**)

Embroidery/Sewing Machine

In this month's project we will edit two designs to create one design. We will explore Grouping and Ungrouping designs. Aligning objects. Using our duplicate option. Splitting a design if necessary for your hoop size.

We are constructing an apron with straps and a tie long enough to cover well and adding an eight inch Insulbrite Fleece panel so we can use our apron to remove hot items from the oven to table. Enjoy the Spring look.
