# 2012 B• Sew Inn Education Challenge

## 2012 Education Challenge General Rules

- 1) Winning Educators from each state will be determined by highest number of documented, qualified points from June 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. The 2011-2012 Education Challenge is open only to FACS Educators and Baby Lock Loaner Program Educators in the states of Arkansas, Missouri and Oklahoma. Educators compete against educators from their own state. Each educator's state is determined by their school address, not home address. B•Sew Inn's Education Division will have complete discretion to settle disputes arising due to address changes and/or location.
- 2) Challenge Points must be completed by the educator, not by students. Students may assist in the learning process. Workbook lessons completed during classroom time qualify provided that the educator was wholly involved, not just observing or assisting students.
- 3) Workbook lessons must be completed on the equipment that the workbook was written for. Example: Baby Lock Evolve Workbook Lessons must be stitched out on the Baby Lock Evolve Serger. Workbook lessons require documentation that must be submitted according to specifications. All documentation must be new work, completed during the current term and not entered in a previous Challenge year. This means that Sew @ Home On-Line classes will only qualify for one Challenge Period if they are taken in the month of June 2011. If you turned them in for last year's Challenge don't turn them in for the 2012 Challenge. You may Re-Take the class for 2012 Challenge Hours. You may also Re-DO a workbook that you completed previously.
- 4) Submission of documented points is the responsibility of the educator. B•Sew Inn Education Division will assist in the tracking of Baby Lock Equipment Loaner Participation Points and Education Division Workshop Points. All other points must be submitted by the educator on the official tracking sheets. Verification of these additional points will be made prior to acceptance. Submission in a timely fashion is suggested. To assist in this process you can download pdf file "Education Challenge Tracker Sheet" from our website.
- 5) Up to 50 Bonus Points can be awarded by B-Sew Inn Education Division for quality and neatness of work.
- 6) In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by drawing between the tied participants.
- 7) Winning Educators will be announced at the 2012 Summer Conferences and/or Summer Conference Open House for each participating state or by website/email if State Conference schedules conflict.
- 8) Accumulated points will not be released to the public prior to the Challenge winner announcement.

## Education Challenge Points

### Qualifying Points will include:

**1) B-Sew Inn Education Division Educator Workshops-2 to 100 points, varied.**

**2) Baby Lock Loaner Program Training Classes-25 Points per piece of equipment.** These are POWER POINTS for the 2012 Challenge

**3) B•Sew Inn Retail Store Guide Classes-2 to 30 points per equipment, varied.** These classes are free on any equipment that is purchased through B•Sew Inn Education Division and through our B•Sew Inn Store locations. Guide Classes on equipment purchased elsewhere are subject to hourly fees. Availability of all Guide Classes is at the discretion and scheduling of each store location. Please refer to our posted calendars on the B-Sew Inn website. Contact should be made directly with each store to schedule a class. Classes have limited space. Register early to avoid disappointment. Verifying documentation must be turned in and validated before these points will be added to your total.

**4) Monthly B•Sew Inn Retail Store Club-10 Points.** Visit [www.bsewinn.com](http://www.bsewinn.com) to view schedule. FYI-Please be certain to check in so that we will be able to validate each Tracker Sheet Attendance Listing against the store's computer record. Club only last about 2 hours but you get five times that amount in Education Challenge Points. Another way to bump up your Challenge Points.

**5) Baby Lock Sew@Home classes-30 Education Challenge Points per On-Line Class.** Visit [www.bsewinn.com](http://www.bsewinn.com) OR [www.babylock.com](http://www.babylock.com) for class description These classes typically take 1.5 to 2 hours to complete. For the 2012 Challenge, they qualify for 30 Education Challenge Points because they are classified as POWER POINTS. Access Codes purchased from the B-Sew Inn Education Division, Education Division Special Event door prizes and codes that come pre-packaged with outgoing Loaner or B-Sew Inn Education Division Purchased Software qualify. It is NOT necessary to own the software for each class that is taken. Sew@Home Software Classes utilize webex technology and you will see the educator's screen during the class.

**6) Educator Get-Social Tasks -50 Education Challenge Points per month-**

This a Quick Monthly Activity that participants can complete to accumulate more Challenge Points. Details will post on our Schools & Educator's Page of the [www.bsewinn.com](http://www.bsewinn.com) website each month so that you know what each new task requires. The activity will focus on textiles, technology and social networking. Example: November's Get Social Task is to take a digital photo of a current classroom activity. It can include students, and of course, we hope it includes sewing (but it is not required). #### **7) B•Sew Inn Special Events-2 to 75 Points, varied**

Many times the points can not be calculated until after the event because it is necessary to see how much emphasis was placed on instruction vs entertainment.

**8) Classroom In-Service Visits**-scheduling and allotment of points is at the sole discretion of the B-Sew Inn Education Division. Not all classroom visits will qualify for Challenge Points.

#### **9) Baby Lock and DG Workbook Lessons & SAH Learning Guides**

## Workbook & Learning Guide Documentation

In order for Completed Workbook & Learning Guide Lessons to qualify for Challenge Points we must receive the required documentation listed for each lesson. All documentation must be new work and not entered in a previous Challenge year, however you may RE-DO a workbook that you previously completed and sent in.

## How to Complete Workbook & Learning Guide Documentation

Purchase a workbook that matches a Baby Lock Machine that you can work on. Find that workbook's matching section in this file (begins on page 9). It will have the name of your workbook at the top of the page. Be sure to select carefully or the pages won't match up. On the remainder of the page it will list page numbers in the Workbook that you will turn to and read. On the line beneath each page section, you will find the word Documentation. To the left of that word it will tell you what you need to do for that page. Sometimes you are reading, sometimes you are sewing, and sometimes you are working on the computer, then sewing.

For the example below:

**Page 31** - 5 Education Challenge Points

*Documentation-send a sample of the three stitches illustrated on this page*

- 1) Turn to page 31 and read the information.
- 2) Sew a small sample of each of the 3 stitches that were covered on this page.
- 3) Label your sample as instructed below and fill out the tracker sheet
- 4) Send your sample to the address below before the deadline.

*Once it is received and checked for accuracy,  
we will add 5 Education Challenge Points added to your total.*

Documentation does not have to be completed on fancy fabric, but please use proper materials, i.e. embroidery samples should be completed with stabilizer, embroidery thread, and proper bobbin thread. **Incorrect samples will only receive partial credit.**

### Labeling your samples:

Please label each sample with the workbook, page number and when applicable, the TYPE of stitch/technique that your sample refers to. We recommend stapling your sample to a sheet of paper with the printed details. Please don't forget to fill out your tracker sheet for each workbook or activity.

Most of this workbook can be used with any Baby Lock Sewing Machine, but there are going to be exceptions, especially if stitching on an entry-level mechanical and/or an older machine.

(Example: The Edge Joining Foot will not fit on the BL8800.) If your Baby Lock machine is unable or unequipped to complete a specific task, you will need to switch to a different Baby Lock model OR simply not complete that particular lesson.

*The first 37 pages of this workbook give basic information about each foot and require a small sample of a technique. A quick snippet. — As you move farther in the workbook you will build on that information and learn multiple applications. I have allotted points for both work levels.
