Louise Cutting a contributing editor to Thread's and the spokesperson for Rowenta Irons has lectured many times at the ASG National Conference, The Sewing and Stitching Expo in Puyallup, WA, The Original Sewing and Quilting Expo, and Martha Pullen's Market Place. Her speaking engagements and 'Sit and Sews' have included many independent fabric stores, local ASG chapters around the country, Bishop Sewing Groups and Fiber Artist Guilds.

The Home and Garden Television (HGTV) program 'Sew Much More' with Susan Khalje, asked Louise to co-host two segments. She spoke on the 'East Meets West' Kimono techniques and 'One-Seam Pants'© custom fit. Both are from her 'Cutting Line Design' Pattern Company. The programs have aired many times on HGTV and DIY, it's sister station. Louise has been a guest on Sue Hausmann's "America Sews" for PBS and Martha Pullen's PBS Sewing Series. She believes that "The sewing customer whether she is sewing for herself or using a dressmaker, should have the same opportunity to acquire the best products that the top designers have available to them". Fabrics, interfacing and patterns must be quality products.

Louise designs patterns for women that are flattering to them and also compatible to their lifestyle. Her pattern company has become a favorite among those who sew garments. She is a versatile, knowledgeable presenter who provides lots of fun in her seminars with her ever-present humor.

Linda Lee is the owner of The Sewing Workshop Pattern Collection, a group of patterns for distinctive garments using innovative sewing techniques. She is a licensed interior designer and member of ASID since 1974. Linda is featured in the Bernina "Portrait of the Artist" national advertising campaign. She travels the country teaching fine sewing techniques and the art of combining beautiful fabrics and distinctive design in garment creation and home decorating creations. She has written thirteen books. A recent book, Sew Sensational Pillows, won the Independent Book Award in 2005 in the Craft and Hobby category.
